The Olympic Medal Reward Scheme

The Olympic Medal Reward Scheme acknowledges excellent standards of attendance, contribution to the community, progress and achievement in subject areas as well as demonstration of the Olympic / Paralympic Values. The scheme has been developed in consultation with both the student body, and staff at UTC Sheffield Olympic Legacy Park and will continue to be reviewed annually in consultation with these groups. Medals in the form of Badges and Certificates will be awarded on a termly basis through Praise assemblies. Badges can be worn on student lanyards, Silver superseding Bronze etc. Certificates will be stored as part of the Cutlers Passport which documents student successes and development of employability skills.

Specific Reward Medals and Certificates for Cutlers Passport

Attendance Medals

Bronze	98% or better Attendance in one term – awarded termly
Silver	98% or better Attendance in three consecutive terms – awarded yearly
Gold	98% or better Attendance in four consecutive terms – awarded at the end of the Christmas and Easter terms of Year 11 and Year 13

Student Ambassador Medals

Silver	– support at 3 events over the Year – awarded termly
Gold	– support at 5 events over the Year – awarded termly

Specialism Star Medals

Awarded for sustained high attainment, and or exceeding personal best in specialism subjects *Sport, Health, and Computing*

Awarded termly to one or two students in each Year group as nominated by Specialism Lead Tutor in consultation with tutors in the department

Curriculum Star Medals

Awarded for sustained high attainment, and or exceeding personal best in core subjects *GCSE Maths, English, Science – Biology/Physics/Chemistry, French, Geography, Psychology, Computing, Sport*

A Level Maths, Further Maths, Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Psychology, English, Computing, EPQ
Awarded termly to one or two students in each Year group as nominated by Curriculum Director in consultation with tutors in the department

Olympian Values Medals

Awarded for significant contributions in the following areas for one or two students in each Year group as nominated by UTC staff: -

Respect
Inspiration
Equality
Excellence

Student Board Lanyard

Awarded to students serving on student UTC board

The Platinum Award (*discretionary*)

At the end of your education at the UTC, exceptional performance may result in you achieving the Platinum Award as recognition of your continued effort, achievement and support during your time at the UTC. Exceptional performance will be determined by a number of factors. The Platinum Award will be presented by the Principal/Executive Principal.
